Mr. Al-Olama is the Chairman of Bidayaat, the region's first childcare company that aims to foster a growing generation of young children to become global citizens of the future by driving world-class social, cultural and educational programs that nurture children to become active and productive community members. Bidayaat supports Mr. Al-Olama's personal and professional commitment to help nurture and strengthen social sustainability across the United Arab Emirates.

Badr Al-Olama is also a Senior Vice President for Mubadala Aerospace & Engineering Services since 2005, is the Chief Executive at Strata Manufacturing PJSC – a Mubadala wholly-owned advanced composite aerostructures manufacturing facility based in the city of Al Ain, the United Arab Emirates. Strata currently has over \$7.5 billion worth of contracts in place to produce aircraft parts for both Airbus and Boeing, and is the first facility of its kind in the Middle East.

In his role with Mubadala, Mr. Al-Olama was responsible for the development of Nibras – the Al Ain Aerospace Park, which is a joint initiative between Mubadala and Abu Dhabi Airports Company. Nibras will be serving aerospace businesses, and attracting global aerospace organizations to establish their regional bases in the Emirate of Abu Dhabi and city of Al Ain.

Prior to his tenure with Mubadala, Mr. Al-Olama was an advocate and legal consultant at Habib Al-Mulla and Company. A graduate of Harvard Law School in 2005 and the College of Shari'ah and Law at the UAE University in 2002, Mr. Al-Olama has contributed to a number of seminars and delegations. He has published articles addressing the legal implications relating to Aviation Accidents in Al Bayan Newspaper and Gulf News, and published his thesis on "Jurisdictional Conflicts in the Context of the Dubai International Financial Centre – The Spill-Over Effect" during his time at Harvard Law School.

Mr. Al-Olama serves on the Board of Directors at Abu Dhabi Aircraft Technologies and SR Technics, and also serves as the president of the UAE Harvard Alumni Society.
