Personal History:

Mr. Tsukamoto is a General Manager of EU-Japan Centre for Industrial Cooperation.

He had previously worked for Japan's Ministry of International Trade and Industry, and held various positions including Director, Policy planning office, Deputy Director- General for Global Environment affairs. After MITI, he worked as a President of Japan Electronics and Information Technology Industries Association (JEITA) and later as a President, Japan External Trade Organization (JETRO). In 2010, he was in Shanghai as the Commissioner General of the Japanese section Expo Shanghai 2010 and also served as the chairman, the Steering Committee at the World Expo Shanghai 2010.

Mr. Tsukamoto graduated from the faculty of Law, Kyoto University in 1968 and a Visiting Research Fellow, Royal Institute of International Affairs office (Chatham House) London (1986-1987).
